<b>TOURNAMENT – INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIP</b>
---

- a. Championship will be played over 54 Holes Gross Stroke Play for Categories A, B & C (Boys & Girls) at Ridge & Valley sub-courses, at Classic Golf & CC (CGR).
- b. There shall be 54 Holes Gross Stroke Play for all Category D (Boys & Girls), Canyon, at Classic Golf & CC.
- c. There shall be 27 Holes Gross Stroke Play for Category E (Boys & Girls), at Canyon at Classic Golf & CC.
- d. No cut shall be applied.

- e. The championship shall be decided by Three rounds of 18 holes each for Age categories A, B, C & D; whereas Category E plays three rounds of 9 Holes each day – all played by stroke in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, and the local rules approved by the championship Committee.
- f. The Team/player with the lowest aggregate gross score for the tournament shall be the winner.
- g. In the event of a tie or ties for the first place, there will be “Sudden Death” Play off, hole by hole, immediately after the completion of the stipulated round. The team event playoff will be conducted/played as Foursomes (Tee markers of the higher category within the team will be used from the teeing grounds).
- h. The Tournament Committee will decide the sequence of the play off. For all other ties the basis for deciding will be the lowest score over the final round, if tied, last 9, 6, 3, & last hole respectively (Back Nine of the course – Hole Nos.10-18).

TOURNAMENT - TEAM FORMAT
--------------------------

- I. There shall be a team event for categories as set out below. There shall be a separate team (Boys & Girls each) for Categories A & B put together and separate for Cat C & D. Each participating country may nominate up to a maximum of Three (3) Teams, in each of the categories.
- II. The Boys Team (AB) shall comprise of two (2) players- one from Age Category A and one from Category B. The Boys Team (CD) shall comprise of two (2) players, one each from Category C and Category D. the Girls Team (A&B) and (C&D) shall comprise of two (2) players, in any combination of the two combined categories. See illustration of team composition as below :-

- III. The team Championship, for the Boys and Girls event, shall consist of 54 holes. The total of the team's gross score for the 3 rounds shall constitute the team's score for the championship. The team returning the lowest aggregate gross score for the championship shall be the winner.
- IV. Team members shall be named and notified in writing to the Tournament Committee at [info@albatross.co.in](mailto:info@albatross.co.in) during Captain's meeting on November 13, 2018 or such other time as may be informed. Each country may nominate maximum of Three (3) teams for each category.
- V. Disqualification of any team member in any round under the Rules of Golf shall not affect a subsequent round unless the Tournament Committee deems otherwise.

## AWARDS AND PRIZES

### 1. Boys and Girls Team Championship

The Albatross Trophy shall be awarded to the Boys and Girls Team Champions as well as Runner-up in both categories (teams with the lowest 3-day total score). In addition, Individual Prizes will be awarded to the members of the winning team.

### 2. Individual Championship

- a. Trophies and prizes will be awarded to the Winner and 4 Runner's-up of Boys Category's A, B, C & D.
- b. Trophies and prizes will be awarded to the Winner and 3 Runner's-up of Girls Category's A, B, C & D.
- c. Trophies and prizes shall be awarded to the Winner and 2 Runner's-up in Boys Category E.
- d. Trophies and prizes shall be awarded to the Winner and 2 Runner's-up in Girls Category E.

IF THERE ARE LESS THAN 5 ENTRIES IN  
ANY OF THE CATEGORIES,  
INDIVIDUAL PRIZES MAY BE  
AWARDED ONLY TO THE WINNER  
AND RUNNER-UP IN THAT CATEGORY.

#### OFFICIAL PRACTICE ROUND

Players are entitled to one Official Free practice round on Tuesday, November 13, 2018 at Classic Golf & CC. Pairings & tee times will be published/ available at the Registration desk in advance and shall also be uploaded on the web site [www.albatross.co.in](http://www.albatross.co.in) & Club/Hotel notice board, two days prior to the competition. **All players are required to vacate the course by 1500 H.**

Early arrivals/Players may avail an additional Practice round/s prior to the competition, by booking directly with the Host Club, on payment of requisite concessional Green Fees, as applicable, to Host Club.

**It may be noted that Golf Course is closed for weekly maintenance every Monday, including Monday November 12, 2018.**

Participating Players / Parents may directly contact Hyatt Regency. The Concessional Special Tariff for Participants/Families has been arranged at Indian Rupees 6500/- or approx \$95.00 (USD 1 = Rs 70/-), inclusive of Breakfast, Wi-Fi & Requisite taxes. Free shuttles (hotel-golf course-hotel) will be provided for players & parents staying at the official hotel.

#### TRANSPORTATION

Transportation/transfers (both ways) will be provided for each Organization/Association/Federation/team (including official) from Indira Gandhi International Airport (Terminal – 3), New-Delhi, India. A charge of \$ 50 (INR 3,500) will apply for two-way airport transfers & shuttle between hotel & golf course, for international non-players/parents. A consolidated charge of Rs 2,500 will apply to domestic non-players/parents, for shuttle service for 4 days (official hotel-golf course-hotel). There is no extra charge for shuttle service/transportation for the players registered for the tournament (Shuttle schedule/timings will be available at the Lobby of the Hotel & golf course). Free shuttle will also be provided to those staying at the official hotel, to the city /shopping mall, on Nov 14 & 15th.

A full day road trip (Luxury Bus) to visit Taj Mahal (Agra city), is scheduled on November 17<sup>th</sup>, for overseas players/parents, approx cost \$ 35 (INR 2,500) per head, plus Entry fee \$ 15, payable at actuals on site, by individuals. Cost of meals/refreshments en-route would be made/borne directly by individuals

#### DRESS CODE

The dress code for the opening ceremony and buffet dinner is Team shirt/blazer/coat and for other scheduled events smart golf attire. International players are encouraged to wear team shirts for official ceremonies. It is the responsibility of each player to be aware of and abide by, the Dress Code of the Host Club. A copy of this will be pasted on the Information Board at the Tournament Office. Both on and off the Course and in the Clubhouse, players should observe reasonable, in-offensive manner of dress allowing for tropical conditions. In general, however, Denim wear including jeans, Swimwear, tracksuits, foot-ball shorts, slippers & sandals are not permitted. Shirts should be collared and worn inside trousers / shorts / skirts. Footwear should be worn at all times, not changed in public areas and notice taken of Host Club rules regarding spike shoes. Dress code for the Awards Presentation ceremony will be Team blazers/smart golf attire. **Track pants/shorts/round neck shirts/Polo, open footwear/rubber slippers are not permitted during closing ceremony.**

#### CAPTAIN'S MEETING

A Captain's meeting is scheduled on **November 14, 2018 at 11:00 AM at Tournament Office (Albatross Hall)** at Classic Golf & CC. Captains from each Team are requested to attend. The Team Captains will be provided a Captain tag, tournament welcome pack & briefing notes for the tournament. Team Capt's (minimum contingent/team of 4 players) may be provided golf carts, if available, during the competition.

#### PRACTICE RANGE/BAG STORAGE FACILITIES

The practice range will be functional from 06:30 am to 6:00 pm. Green fee is exempt for competitors and range balls will be made available at subsidized rates, to Albatross players.

Limited bag storage facility, on first come first served basis, is available at the CGR club-house/Pro-shop.

#### FOOD & BEVERAGE

Buffet Breakfast will be provided to players staying at the official hotel. All Participants are required to attend Welcome & Closing Ceremonies. Venues & time will be informed subsequently. Friends and family may obtain coupons/attend the official opening ceremony and Awards presentation Lunch at Rs 1500/- per person (subject to availability).

#### WEATHER

The weather in mid-November is expected to be pleasant (during day) with chilly mornings & nights and relatively dry and sunny at that time of the year. Light woolens/wind-breakers/jackets may be required in the mornings and after sun-set. Temperatures are expected to be in the range of 9 - 20 °C.

#### **INSURANCE/FOREIGN EXCHANGE/LOCAL SIM CARDS**

All overseas competitors & accompanying parents are advised & responsible to carry adequate personal and medical insurance.

**It is recommended that all overseas players avail foreign exchange/local currency at the International airport, due to absence of such facilities close to the golf course.**

All interested overseas players, for ease of convenience, may obtain local India phone SIM cards (service providers- Airtel/Vodafone/Idea, recommended) at the Airport, on arrival.

#### **REGISTRATION & ALBATROSS BADGE**

Players are required to register personally (Team Capt's may check-in their players) on **November 13, 2017, 9 am– 3 pm at Registration Desk**. Players will receive the Welcome Pack which may include – week's schedule, Albatross bulletin of good behavior, Player badges, Souvenirs and coupons for F & B. All Players will receive an official Albatross ID Tag. The Registration is MANDATORY for all participants/players.

The player tag must be carried at all times. This badge allows player's access to Restaurants, ceremonies and practice areas. The badge also permits access to recreational activities at CGR.

One registered official/Team captain per country will also receive an official badge & welcome pack. Team Capt's may be permitted to hire golf buggies to follow their respective teams/players, on the course.

#### **FAMILY AND FRIENDS**

Parents, Siblings, Relations & Friends are all welcome to witness the competition. Parents may have meals at the clubhouse/ on course on direct payment. Parents may also participate in any of the ceremonies on payment of requisite charges which will be intimated at the time of registration of the player.

#### **ARRIVAL/DEPARTURES**

Players/Teams are expected to arrive on November 12<sup>th</sup>. Overseas teams are required to intimate flight arrival details (latest by November 5<sup>th</sup>) to facilitate airport transfers/pick-ups. **International/overseas players, planning to visit Taj Mahal may plan departure late night flights on Nov 17<sup>th</sup> (after 2200 H), or thereafter.**

Domestic/Out station players, desirous of leaving on Nov 16th (final day of competition), may plan their departures on late evening flights (preferably after 2000 H), to cater for Awards ceremony (will finish by 1730 H) and evening rush hour traffic.
