## Terrific day for the Thais

**GURGAON:** Twelve-year-old Thai lad Puwit Anupansuebai renewed his love with the Classic Golf Resort here by firing a five-under 67 to take the lead in Category 'C' of the third Albatross junior golf championship which began here on Wednesday.

Puwit, winner of Category 'D' by a whopping 24 strokes in 2009, enjoyed a seven-stroke lead over Dubai's Rayhan Thomas and India's Adil Bir Singh. Among the girls, Amrita Anand led with a 75.

Surprisingly in Category 'A', there were no par scores with Manu Gandas, Rohan Govil and Abhishek Kuhar sharing the lead with cards of 74. Japan's Ayaka Nakayama was the best girl on view with a 75.
